The library webpages offers platform to the users to navigate the related information about library. This study presents a webometric study focused on the 12 Social work college library webpages of Nagpur District (Maharashtra). Study examines the domain, domain age, domain registration date, internal and external links and total links, web impact factor of Social Work college library webpages. To collect data for this study, smallseotools.com and similarweb.com had used to find out domain age, domain authority, page authority and total, internal and external links of college library websites covered in this study.

Introductions:

The Web is playing an important role in diverse application domains such as business, education, health sector, industry and entertainment. The World Wide Web (WWW) has become a major source of information foe academic and research activities. Website play a key role in dissemination of information effectively and efficiently. Webometric analysis is one of the established methods used to analyze websites. The term webometrics was coined by Thomas C. Almind and Peter Ingwersen (1977).Bojorneborne and Ingwersen (2004) defines it as "the study of the quantitative aspects of the construction and the use of information resources, structure, and technologies on the World Wide Web drawing on informetric and bibliometric approaches.

For the dissemination of information and spreading of communication web has played a significant role. Websites and web based user interfaces have become the window of communication in today's world (Sarkar and Pal, 2018). In case of the Social Work Colleges websites, they have sublime role to play. In disseminating valuable information regarding various updates regarding admission, result, programmes, various schemes, services etc. However the purpose of exploring the present status of the Social work College websites of India, the present study has been conducted.

Review of Literature:

Thelwall, Tang, and Price (2003) conducted a "webometric analysis of universities across 16 European nations" to examine academic interconnections. Their findings indicated that university websites were more likely to link to institutions in geographically proximate countries. Similar trends may also be observed within individual countries, such as the UK (Thelwall, 2002) and Canada (Vaughan, 2007; Vaughan & Thelwall, 2003)

In the research titled "Web Impact Factor and Link Analysis of Selected Indian Universities" carried out by Jalal, Biswas, and Mukhopadhyay (2010), the authors examine the relevance and importance of the web impact factor for the websites of Indian universities. The results indicated a significant correlation among the National Institutes of Technology (NITs) regarding their activities, in contrast to state and central universities, which exhibited weaker connections in their topology.

Brahma Krishna and Verma Manoj Kumar (2019) analyze the websites of nine public libraries across India. The research reveals that the National Library of India leads with the highest Page Authority at 21%, Total Linking Root Domains at 68%, the highest External Equity-Passing Links at 97%, Total Equity-Passing Links at 88%, Total External Links at 97%, and Total Links

at 87%. It was also found that the Internal Web Impact Factor for most public libraries is quite low, indicating a need for website improvement.

Dhar Prasenjit and Gayan Mithu Anjali (2022) carried out a "webometric study of selected International Library Association websites." A link analysis tool https://moz.com/ was utilized for data collection to evaluate Domain Authority, Page Authority, in-links, and out-links. The findings indicated that regarding link dynamics, 4 out of 8 (50%) of the websites had a higher number of external links compared to internal links, and 7 out of 8 (87.5%) of the international library association websites had a Domain Authority and Page Authority below 50. Important information, such as customer service, currency, and FAQs, is missing from the websites. **Objectives of the Study:**

- To analyse the URL of Social Work College websites of Nagpur District.
- To examine the domain age, domain authority and page authority of Social Work College library webpages.
- To identify the link analysis of Social work College
